PRESS NOTE

Inviting of applications against the allocation of 4 (four) MBBS seats from Central Pool for spouse and children of Civilian Victims of Terrorism for the academic year 2024-25

It is brought to the notice of all concerned that as per the communication received from the Under Secretary to the Govt. of India, Ministry of Home Affairs, CTCR Division, New Delhi, the following 4 (four) MBBS seats has been earmarked from the Central Pool for **spouse and children of Civilian Victims of Terrorism** in the following medical colleges/institutes for nomination for the academic year 2024-25 :-

The Ministry further informed that the following order of priority has been prescribed for allocation of aforesaid MBBS seats to the spouse or children of Civilian Victims of Terrorism :-

- (a) Priority-I:** Children whose both parents have been killed by terrorists.
- (b) Priority-II:** Children of families whose sole bread earners has been killed by terrorists.
- (c) Priority-III:** Wards of victims with permanent disability and serious injury caused by terrorist operations.

The Eligibility Criteria is as under:-

- (i) Candidate must either be spouse or children of the deceased/disable civilian victim of terrorism.
- (ii) He/She has complete 17 years of age at the time of admission or will complete that age on or before 31 December of the year of his/her admission to the first year of the Undergraduate Medical Course and is an Indian National.

- (iii) Educational Qualification :

The candidate must have passed in subjects of Physics, Chemistry, Biology/Bio-Technology and English individually and must have obtained a minimum of 50% marks (40% for SC-PWD/ST-PWD/OBC-PWD (persons with disability) category candidates) taken together in Physics, Chemistry, Biology at the qualifying examination of 12th Class.

- (iv) Qualifying percentile in NEET (UG)- 2024 :

As per Graduate Medical Education Regulations of National Medical commission, it shall be necessary for the candidates to obtain minimum marks at 50th percentile at NEET (UG)-2024. For SC, ST & OBC, the minimum marks shall be at 40th percentile. In respect of candidates with special disability, the minimum marks shall be at 45th percentile.

Accordingly, application in the prescribed format (**Annexure-I**), in duplicate enclosing all necessary documents are invited from interested/eligible candidates for allocation of said MBBS seats earmarked from the Central Pool for **spouse and children of Civilian Victims of Terrorism**.

The duly filed-in application enclosing all necessary documents including the documentary evidence of Civilian Victim of Terrorism may be submitted in person **to the Development-IV Section, Secretariat, Port Blair on or before 13th September, 2024 upto 5.00 pm positively**. Incomplete application summarily be rejected.

No application will be entertained or accepted after the expiry of the stipulated date and time as specified above.
